

Clinical Results Show Divine 9 Lubricant is a Breakthrough in Reducing Cancer-causing HPV Infections

Based on data from 280 participants, the women using the Divine 9 personal lubricant with proprietary CarraShield® plant extract had fewer new HPV infections over a 6 to 12 month period as compared to women using a placebo lubricant. The Divine 9 lubricant has been specially formulated with a proprietary blend of natural sea algae extracts called CarraShield that had been shown to block HPV in earlier laboratory studies conducted by the National Cancer Institute. These new results represent the first time in the history of HPV research that a topical gel in the form of a personal lubricant has been shown to significantly decrease the number of HPV infections in women.

Divine 9 is the first and only personal lubricant undergoing large scale human clinical studies on HPV prevention.
